Wondering what you can do to help the PTSA? Here's your chance! The PTSA works with Mrs. Long, the staff at FCES and parents to find out what programs and events we love having at our school. All of these programs and events benefit the students at FCES. We are fortunate to have numerous volunteers who chair the amazing events and programs at FCES. Below is a list of chair positions that are open for the 2019-2020 school year. Please read the description next to each chair to gain an understanding of what the job entails. Several of the positions are only for a short period of time, but can't happen without your help!

**Fall Conference Luncheon Chair:** The Fall Conference Luncheon Chair only needs to be available for a few days during the month of November during conferences. This person organizes a lunch for teachers during the week of fall conferences, which will be held in November. The Fall Luncheon Chair is responsible for getting donations of food and/or volunteers to bring in food for the lunch, setting up the lunch and cleaning up the lunch.

**Family Dinner Chair:** The Family Dinner Chair requires a time commitment of two evenings per year plus additional planning and shopping for each evening. This person will be responsible for ordering pizzas for the two family dinners (Family Art Night and Spring Fundraiser Night), purchasing side items to go with the pizza and coordinating volunteers for help. Food ordering/purchasing estimates will be available from dinners in previous years.

**Volunteer Coordinator:** The Volunteer Coordinator is a year-long commitment. The responsibilities entail creating sign-ups via Sign-Up Genius for Book Fair, Walk-A-Thon, Science Fair and Spring Fundraiser and help find volunteers for these events. Additionally, you will work with Jennie Uhles to create sign-ups for health screenings and individual and class picture days and assist with finding volunteers to fill the positions. Lastly, the Volunteer Coordinator will assist program chairs in creating sign-ups and finding volunteers as needed throughout the year.

**Walk-A-Thon Treasurer:** The WAT Treasurer would ideally have some experience in accounting or banking. This person will work closely with the WAT Chair and will be responsible for collecting and counting money throughout the month of October for WAT. The time commitment is only for one month, but the WAT Treasurer needs to be readily available during the entire month of October. Previous WAT Treasurers will be available to answer questions that may arise.

### **Fall City Day Run 2019**

This is the Fall City Day Run's 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary! It will take place Saturday, June 8 beginning at 9:00am. There will be a Kids 1k, as well as the 5k and 10k races. This annual event raises funds for SVSD schools and youth groups. Since 2013, over \$55,000 has been donated back to our community. Since 2013, \$21,622 has been donated to Fall City Elementary School. Some of the proceeds donated to FCES were recently used to purchase and install new playground equipment (in October 2018).

We are encouraging as many FCES families to participate as possible. ALL proceeds from the race go back to SVSD schools, and specifically to the schools for which one self-assigns during race registration.
